Comfort Foods

Slow Cooker Cheesy Potato Casserole

You will need:

- Crockpot
- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 container Philadelphia Cooking Crème - Original Flavor
- 6 slices of bacon
- 1 bag Ore Ida Hashbrowns
- 1 box of Velveeta Cheese, 8 oz. size
- 32 oz. chicken broth
- 1 small onion, diced



- Fry up the hamburger. Cook the bacon in the microwave and crumble. Dump all ingredients in the crockpot. Place on high for about 4 to 5 hours, stirring occasionally. Serve with fried onions on top.

Chocolate M&Ms Cake Mix Cookies

Ingredients:

- 15.25 oz. package chocolate cake mix
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 2 Tablespoons Hershey's Chocolate Syrup
(2 Tbsp of water may be substituted)
- 1-1/2 cups m&m's milk chocolate candies

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. In a large bowl combine egg, butter, and syrup, and cake mix with and electric mixer on low speed until thoroughly mixed.
3. Add m&m's, about a half cup at a time, stirring in with a wooden spoon. Drop rounded tablespoons 2 inches apart onto an ungreased cookie sheet.
4. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes. Cool on wire racks.
