Holiday Bark

- 12oz semi sweet choc chips
- 8oz white choc chips
- 2 oreos chopped/2 candy canes chopped
- 1/3 cup of andes chip mints
- 1/4 cup Holiday mini m&m's



In 2 separate bowls, melt the chocolate and white chocolate according to package instructions. Line a 10"x10" pan with parchment paper sprayed with cooking spray. Pour melted chocolate into pan and smooth onto an even layer. Pour white chocolate over chocolate layer and smooth out evenly. Take a toothpick and gently swirl the chocolates together to make a pretty design. Immediately sprinkle on toppings and let set at room temperature for about an hour or until chocolate is solid. Remove from pan and parchment paper and break into pieces. Store in a sealed container at room temperature. Enjoy!
